About the project

"Documentary Theatre: Words that matter!" is a Youth Exchange which will be held in Braga, Portugal.

The project has an APV before the Youth Exchange itself.

APV will be done from 5th of November (arrival day) till the 8th of November (departure day) for a total of 12 participants (2 per country).

Youth Exchange will be done from 1st of December (arrival day) till the 10th of December (departure day) for a total of 42 participants (7 per country).

<u>Countries involved:</u> Portugal, Poland, Greece, Latvia, Finland and Turkey.




About the project

The aim of the youth exchange is to raise awareness to the current and ongoing migration crisis and to combat all forms of racisms, exclusion, xenophobia and hate-speech in specfic towards this target.

To achieve this goal we have decided to use theatre as an artistic approach, in specific, VERBATIM.

Verbatim theatre brings social issues to the stage by emphasizing factual information over aesthetic considerations. The creator starts a dialogue with the audience by focusing on the psychological and interpersonal aspect of a particular event. It sits at the intersection of art and engagement with the general public and can be seen as a catalyst for social change.



Working Methods

All the Youth Exchange activities will be done through the methods of non-formal education.

The activities will be for example brainstorming together, plenary discussions, simulations, role plays, team building, energizers, ice breakers and many others. Non-formal education is voluntary, non hierarchical and all its methods are based on the concept of learning by doing.



PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

The participants involved in this project will be people interested in theatre and the migration topic, and according to the following profile:

- A minimum age of 18 and maximum of 29, except for the group leader that has no restrictions;
- Strong motivation to learn and acquire new skills;
- Attitude for dialogue and mutual understanding;
- Gender Balance have to be followed as much as possible;
- Priority will be given to youth with fewer opportunities background;


ABOUT TICKETS

VENUE & HOW TO REACH BRAGA (PORTUGAL)



Venue and accomodation of the project will be in BRAGA and will be announced in the next days as soon as the place is confirmed.

To travel to PORTUGAL and reach the venue in BRAGA you need to travel to OPORTO Airport (~45min from Braga). Other option, in case you cannot manage through OPORTO, is to travel to LISBON Airport (~3-4 hours from Braga).
